Life Story

Candi Danette Stewart was born on December 19, 1963 in Portland, Oregon, to her parents, Craig L. Stewart and Billye Jean Stewart.

Her early childhood and young adult life was spent in Portland. Upon graduation from high school, she moved to Dallas, Texas where she attended The Fashion and Art Institute of Dallas

After the birth of Candi's eldest child, Brandi, she returned to Portland, where her other two daughters, Morgan and Whitney were born.

In 1989, Candi returned to Oklahoma and settled in Norman. She received the Lord Jesus Christ into her life on January 7, 1990 at Community Missionary Baptist Church of Norman. Shortly afterward, Candi and Quincy Davis, Sr. were united in marriage and to this union was born one son, Quincy Davis III. Candi remained in Norman for the next 14 years.
